PACKET PICK-UP

For the *runDisney* Kids' Races, please attend Packet Pick-Up on Thursday, January 5, 2012 from 10:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m., and Friday, January 6, 2012 from 2:00 p.m. - 7:00 p.m., in the HP Field House at ESPN Wide World of Sports Complex. We encourage everyone who is participating in the *runDisney* Kids' Races to pick up their race numbers at the Expo.

RACE DAY PACKET PICK-UP

Those who are unable to pick up their race numbers on Thursday, January 5, will be able to do so at the Track & Field Complex at ESPN Wide World of Sports prior to the start of the event. Race Day Packet Pick-Up will begin at 9:30 a.m. on both Friday, January 6 and Saturday, January 7, 2012 and will close at 10:45 a.m. each day. Mickey Mile Packet Pick-Up will close at 12:15 p.m. on Friday, January 6.

COMMEMORATIVE MICKEY EAR PICK-UP

AGE GROUPS

The Kids' Races will be staged in the following age groups:

Mickey Mile: 13 & under (white start flags)

400m dash: 7-8 years old (blue start flags)

200m dash: 4-6 years old (yellow start flags)

100m dash: 1-3 years old (green start flags)

Diaper Dash: 12 months & under (Finish Line)

RACE START

KIDS' DASHES

Each age group will have its own start line, which will be color coded for all parents to easily find. Each participant's bib color matches the starting flag for their distance. We will also have plenty of volunteers on hand to make sure that each of these athletes gets to the correct start line – be sure to listen to the announcer for instructions on exactly what to do! Any parents who wish to run with their children are encouraged to do so.

Participants in all dashes should be at their respective start lines by 10:45 a.m. Race staff will group all Kids' Dashes participants into waves at each starting flag. The dashes will start promptly at 11:00 a.m. at the Track & Field Complex at ESPN Wide World of Sports. The event will follow a rolling schedule beginning with the 1-3 year old competitors, followed by the 4-6 year olds, the 7-8 year olds, and the Diaper Dash.

MICKEY MILE

The Mickey Mile will start promptly at 12:30 p.m. near the Track & Field Complex and will utilize the same finish line as the other Kids' Races at the track. The start line will be marked with a blue flag. When you receive your race bib, your ChronoTrack B-Tag will be attached to the back. The ChronoTrack B-Tag records your official time. Please do not alter the ChronoTrack B-Tag in any way. Without the B-Tag your official time will not be recorded. Mickey Mile participants should be at their start line by 12:15 p.m. (Friday, January 6th only).

BIB NUMBERS

Make sure to wear the Kids' Dash or Mickey Mile bib on race day! Each start line will have feather banners that match the color of the race bibs – green for 100m, yellow for 200m, red for 400m, and blue for the Mickey Mile. Diaper Dash will take place at the finish line.

RACE FINISH

All *runDisney* Kids' Races will utilize the same finish line at the track.

WATER STOPS & REFRESHMENTS

Water and refreshments will be available at the finish line for all race participants. There will be one water stop on the Mickey Mile course.

PHOTOGRAPHERS

Brightroom photographers will be at the finish line to capture those special race memories. Please wear your bib number on the front of your shirt. Visit www2.brightroom.com/disney2012 after the race to view your race photos. Photos usually take between 2-3 days to be loaded onto the website. You will need your race number to access your photos.

AWARDS

All of the *runDisney* Kids' Races competitors are winners! No placement awards will be given out; but all finishers will receive a commemorative medallion at the Finish. Medallions will be given to official *runDisney* Kids' Races participants – parents who choose to run with their kids will not receive a medal.

RACE RESULTS & TIMING

Since everyone is a winner, none of the *runDisney* Kids' Races will be scored. There will be no Race Results for the 400m, 200m, 100m, or Diaper Dash. The Mickey Mile will be timed and participants can view their race times online at disneyworldmarathon.com

RESTRICTIONS

For everyone's safety, walkers, walking sticks, crutches, canes, baby backpacks, baby joggers/strollers, baby carriers, bicycles, inline skates, motorized scooters, skateboards, and animals of any kind are prohibited on the course.

WEATHER

The race will be held rain or shine. If there is lightning in the area, the races will either have delayed starts or, depending on the intensity of the weather, be cancelled. The determination will be made by the Event Management staff.

The Walt Disney World® Lightning Policy is as follows:

Event operations will shut down when lightning is 10 miles out from the event areas. Event operations will not resume until the lightning is 10 miles out moving away from the event areas. The *Flash to Bang Rule* and weather radar will be used to determine this. The Sports Manager will consult with the Theme Park Partners and *Walt Disney World*® Security on a course of action to utilize the operational rain plan, delay the event, or cancel the event.

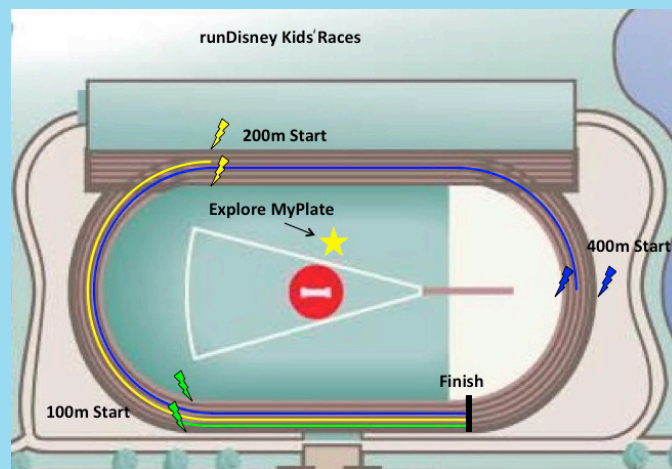
Flash to Bang Rule is applied by measuring the time (in seconds) between a visual lightning "Flash" and hearing the

resulting "Bang". This time is then divided by a factor of "5" to obtain distance in miles. For example, 50 seconds between "Flash" and "Bang" divided by "5" equals 10 miles.

As a reminder, the registration fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.
