PACKET PICK-UP

If you pre-registered for the Disney Kids' Races, please attend Packet Pick-Up on Friday, September 30, 2011 from 10:00 a.m. - 8:00 p.m. at the HP Field House at ESPN Wide World of Sports Complex. We encourage everyone who is participating in the Disney Kids' Races to pick up their race numbers on this day.

RACE DAY PACKET PICK-UP

Those who are unable to pick up their packet on Friday, September 30 will be able to do so at the Track & Field Complex at ESPN Wide World of Sports prior to the start of the event. Race Day Packet Pick-Up for the Disney Kids' Races will begin at 8:30 a.m. and will close at 9:45 a.m.

COMMEMORATIVE MICKEY EAR PICK-UP

Did you pre-order Disney Kids' Races Commemorative Mickey Ears? Don't forget to pick up your Commemorative Mickey Ears during Packet Pick-Up. Please remember that Commemorative Mickey Ears not picked up during Packet Pick-Up will not be mailed or refunded.

EVENT LOCATION

Track and Field Complex at the ESPN Wide World of Sports.

AGE GROUPS

The dashes will be staged in the following age groups:

- 400m Dash: 7-8 years old (blue start flags)
- 200m Dash: 4-6 years old (yellow start flags)
- 100m Dash: 1-3 years old (green start flags)
- Diaper Dash: 12 months & under (Finish Line)

RACE START

Each age group will have its own start line, which will be color coded for all parents to easily find. Each participant's bib color matches the starting flag for their distance. We will also have plenty of volunteers on hand to make sure that each of these athletes gets to the correct start line – be sure to listen to the announcer for instructions on exactly what to do! Any parents who wish to run with their children are encouraged to do so.

Participants in all races should be at their respective start lines by 9:45 a.m. Race staff will group all Disney Kids' Races participants into waves at each starting flag. The Disney Kids' Races will start promptly at 10:00 a.m. at the Track & Field Complex at ESPN Wide World of Sports. The event will follow a rolling schedule beginning with the 1-3 year old competitors, followed by the 4-6 year olds, the 7-8 year olds, and the Diaper Dash.

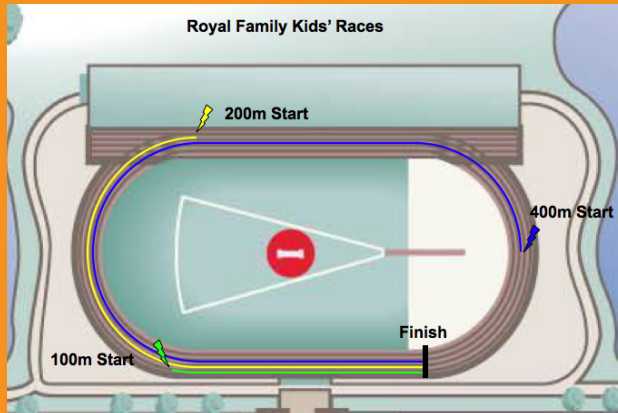
BIB NUMBERS

Make sure to wear the Disney Kids' Races bib on race day! Each start line will have feather banners that match the colored numbers on the race bibs – green for 100m, yellow for 200m, and blue for 400m. Diaper Dash will take place at the finish line.



RACE FINISH

All Disney Kids' Races will utilize the same finish line at the Track.



WATER AND REFRESHMENTS

Water and refreshments will be available at the finish line for all race participants.

PHOTOGRAPHERS

Brightroom photographers will be at the finish line to capture those special race memories. Please wear your bib number on the front of your shirt. Visit www.brightroom.com/disney2011 after the race to view your race photos. Photos usually take between 2-3 days to be loaded onto the web site. You will need your race number to access your photos.

AWARDS

All of the Disney Kids' Races competitors are winners! No placement awards will be given out, but all finishers will receive a commemorative medallion at the Finish. Medallions will be given to official Disney Kids' Races participants – parents who choose to run with their kids will not receive a medallion.

RACE RESULTS & TIMING

Since everyone is a winner, none of the Kids' Races will be scored. There will be no Race Results for the 400m, 200m, 100m or Diaper Dash.

RESTRICTIONS

For everyone's safety, walkers, walking sticks, crutches, canes, baby backpacks, baby joggers/strollers, baby carriers, bicycles, inline skates, motorized scooters, skateboards, and animals of any kind are prohibited on the course.

WEATHER

The race will be held rain or shine. If there is lightning in the area, the races will either have delayed starts or, depending on the intensity of the weather, be cancelled. The determination will be made by the Event Management staff.

The Walt Disney World® Lightning Policy is as follows:

Event operations will shut down when lightning is 10 miles out from the event areas. Event operations will not resume until the lightning is 10 miles out moving away from the event areas. The *Flash to Bang Rule* and weather radar will be used to determine this. The Sports Manager will consult with the Theme Park Partners and **Walt Disney World® Security** on a course of action to utilize the operational rain plan, delay the event, or cancel the event.

Flash to Bang Rule is applied by measuring the time (in seconds) between a visual lightning "Flash" and hearing the resulting "Bang". This time is then divided by a factor of "5" to obtain distance in miles. For example, 50 seconds between "Flash" and "Bang" divided by "5" equals 10 miles.

As a reminder, the registration fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.
